A report stating the total acreage of these soils within the Town would also be of assistance to us.

The Town currently has a soil map included in a previous Master Plan. However, when this was recently reviewed, it became apparent that some important fields currently in agricultural use were not included on this map, which renders it of somewhat questionable value to the Town.
